We also offer independent study courses: BI509, CH509, CM509, and TH509.

Credit for Previous Experiential Learning, Transfer Credits, or Independent Study: None allowed for CTS; six units allowed for DCM; 21 units of transfer/previous learning allowed for MPS or MTS; 36 units of transfer credit combined with experiential learning allowed for the MDiv.

Certificate in Theological Studies (CTS) requires one Bible course, one theology course, and any two electives. Total of 4 courses (12 units). We recommend BI501, BI520, TH507 and CM501.

Diploma in Christian Ministry (DCM) general track requires one Bible course, one course in church history, two courses in Christian ministry, a theology course, and two electives, for a total of 7 courses (21 units).

Diploma in Christian Ministry (DCM) GCI ministry track requires BI501 or BI520, CM504, CM508, CM520, TH503, either another theology course or another Bible course, and an elective based on the area of ministry.

Master of Pastoral Studies (MPS) requires BI501, two biblical electives, one history course, CM501, CM504, two ministry electives, TH501 or 505, two theology electives, two electives from any area, and either CM549 or TM501. Total, 14 courses (42 units).

Master of Theological Studies (MTS) requires BI501, two biblical electives, two church history courses, CM501, TH501, TH502, TH503, two theology electives, two electives from any area, and TH519, for a total of 14 courses (42 units).

Master of Divinity (MDiv) requires BI501, BI522, BI524, one Old Testament course, one Bible elective, two church history courses, CM501, CM503, CM504, CM510, CM511, two ministry electives, three Field Education courses, TH501, TH502, TH503, TH515, two theology electives, one elective from any area, a thesis, and CM599. The thesis may be in either ministry or theology and counts as an elective in that area.

Extensions: For most courses, there is a fee for a three-week extension. Capstone courses are extended into a second semester for free; a third semester may be included for one third of the normal tuition.

^{**}For the MDiv, CM549 and TM501 count as electives in the ministry area; TH519 counts as an elective in theology. Before 2021, TM501 had two options; option B was identical to CM549.
